Re: West 94 Area Transportation Plan – Consultant Selection

In April, the Metro COG Policy Board approved the request for proposals (RFP) for the West 94 Area Transportation Plan. This project has a total budgeted amount of \$300,000 (\$240,000 funded using Federal CPG funds and \$60,000 from the City of West Fargo).

The deadline for consulting firms to submit proposals was May 15<sup>th</sup>. Metro COG received proposals from two firms – Bolton & Menk and SRF.

The consultant selection panel met on Monday, May 20th to interview the firms and select the top ranked firm. Upon interviews with the two consultant teams, Bolton & Menk was the highest ranked firm. Bolton & Menk's sealed cost proposal came in at \$316,378.15 which is over the not-to-exceed budget of \$300,000. After consultation with NDDOT, Metro COG notified Bolton & Menk that they were the top ranked firm, however required them to provide a final cost proposal under \$300,000 without any changes to the scope or staff hours. Failure to do so would result in Metro COG proceeding with the second ranked firm. Bolton & Menk then provided Metro COG with a final cost proposal of \$299,999.24.

#### Requested Action:

Approval of Bolton & Menk as the top ranked firm to complete the West 94 Area Transportation Plan and provide authorization for Metro COG's Executive Director to enter into a contract for services with said consultant.

Re: 15th Ave N Corridor Study – Consultant Selection

The TH10 Corridor Study through Dilworth identified the 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue North as a corridor that could be improved to make regional connections as an alternative to TH10, particularly if a three-lane option is selected. Metro COG included this study in its UPWP Amendment #4 that will utilize unspent 2023 CPG funds. The RFP identified a budget of \$150,000 with a mandatory completion date of December 31, 2024. The local match is being provided by Clay County and the City of Dilworth.

Metro COG received two proposals prior to the proposal deadline on Wednesday May 15, 2024.

Proposals were received from the following consultant teams:

- Apex with subconsultant TC2
- KLJ

The consultant selection panel met with and interviewed the consultant teams on May 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> to further understand each team's technical qualifications, project approach, task deliverables, and past project experiences. The selection was based upon scoring criteria, written technical proposals, and the in-person interviews.

The Selection Committee interviewed the proposing consultant teams, scored, and ranked each team. After rankings were tallied, KLJ was preferred by the Selection Committee to complete the 15th Avenue North Corridor Study.

Due to the aggressive timeline scheduled for this project, Metro COG is asking for an email vote by the TTC to accept the findings of the Selection Committee and allow Metro COG to enter into a contract with KLJ. Metro COG will be holding a special session of the Policy Board on May 24<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. Metro COG is scheduling a meeting with KLJ to develop the final project scope of work.

Metro COG opened the sealed cost proposal submitted by KLJ, and their proposed cost of \$149,973.44 was within the budgeted amount as listed in the RFP.

Requested Action: Approval of KLJ as the preferred team recommended by the study's consultant selection panel to complete the study; and recommend approval for the Executive Director to enter into a contract with said consulting team for the 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Corridor Study.
